

Educational Review (ER)

Once you have registered your intention to enter a Health Education England (HEE) programme the NRO will link you to an HEE Training Programme Director (TPD) in the area you plan to live who will review your training and experience to help guide your formal application and plan your learning needs

They will review your formal application form submitted to the NRO, with a brief CV and a copy of the first Self-Test module (please do not attempt modules 2 and 3 at this stage)

They will also have copies of any certificates of qualification proof of identity, this will usually be a copy of your passport, eligibility for a work visa (if required) and a brief outline of your intentions and plan.

They will arrange and undertake a structured on-line review which will look at your training and experience to help guide you on identifying your learning needs, this should include a review of the first Self-Test module

This review will also help identify and inform your programme pathway and to initiate the process for identification of a suitable clinical placement
